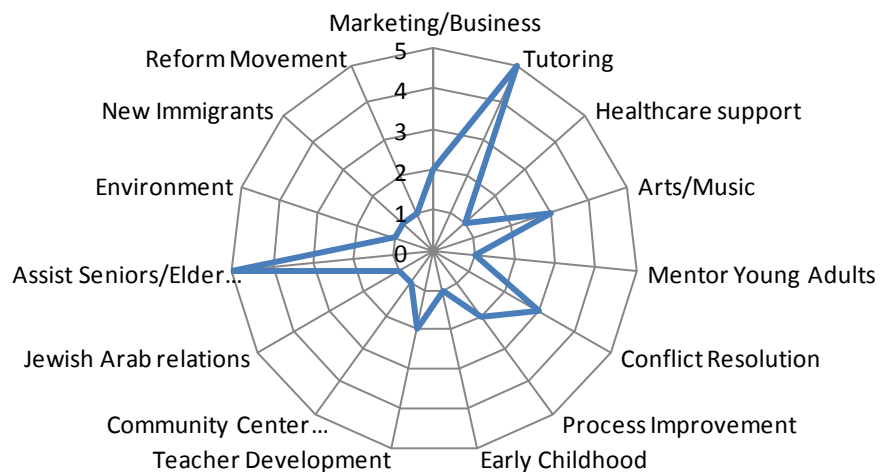

Volunteer Interests



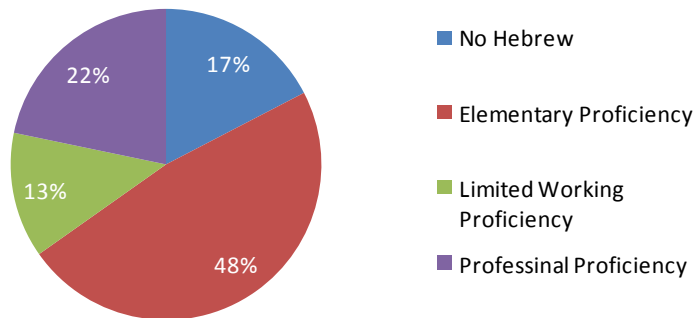
Observations :

- Single individuals reported multiple professions, certifications and licensure
- Professional background does not always predict volunteer interest
- Surveyed population is primarily from the Midwest United States. Broader geographic survey required to validate the results across United States
- Volunteer interests are general ; opportunity for non-profits to specify needs within general areas of interest

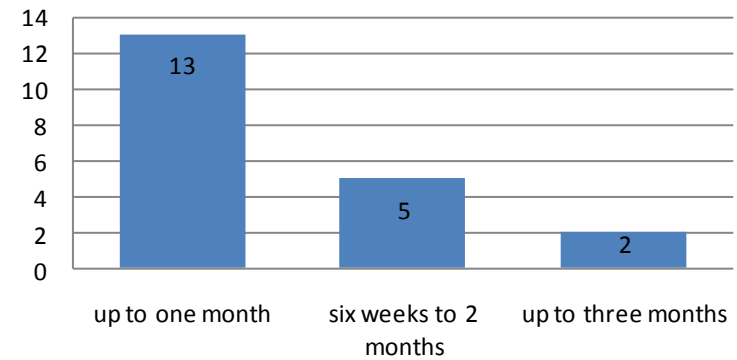
What was learned about volunteering?

- 83% of respondents have some Hebrew language proficiency
- 89% would spend up to 2 months in Israel volunteering, of which 61% prefer to volunteer up to one month
- 50% prefer to volunteer up to 10 hours per week and 33% would volunteer up to 20 hours per week.
- Jerusalem is the preferred location for volunteering.

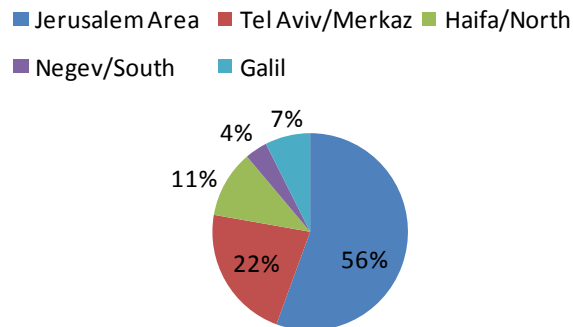
Hebrew Language Proficiency
